

# SAFETY ORIENTATION

## Purpose

To ensure Company employees are provided with training, education and personal protection from the hazardous materials/conditions which may exist in the workplace. Seismic operations are often conducted in potentially hazardous environments. It is our intention to provide employees with proper training, education and to include them in an ongoing safety awareness program.

The program applies to all Company personnel, contractors and visitors involved in all phases of our operations.

## Objective

It is our goal to eliminate lost time injuries and Environmental incidents, to increase personal awareness and to make our operations as safe and productive as possible.

## Method

To address all Safety Procedures, Emergency Procedures, Environmental Policies, through training, education and personal involvement in all phases of our operations.

1. **Awareness Program:** Through our Awareness Program we will make an effort to increase personnel awareness, to invite comments from employees and to make employees an integral part of ensuring that **SAFETY** and **ENVIRONMENT** are the first concerns in all Company operations. It is each and every person's responsibility to contribute to making this a safe operation. Comments will be requested from employees - these will be documented through the near-miss recording program. This will be conducted in a no-fault environment. Suggestions and comments will be reviewed by the Safety Committee; near misses will be reviewed by incident, and names will not be included. Constructive criticism and suggestions will be implemented into the day-to-day operations. This gives YOU and opportunity to contribute, to be heard and to make a difference. Our goal is, as always, to have NO lost time injuries, NO spills and NO environmental incidents.
2. **Safety is the most important aspect of this project.**
  - (a) Safety for you:
    - proper personal protective equipment (PPE)
    - equipment in good working condition
    - healthy working environment
  - (b) Safety for other crew members:
    - buddy system
  - (c) Safety for the environment:
    - waste management/ recycling program
    - wildlife avoidance
    - environmental protection (NO SPILLS)
3. **Layout of vessel:**
  - (a) Muster stations and individual duties in case of emergency;
  - (b) Immersion suits locations;
  - (c) PPE Rules: when and where they are needed;
  - (d) Who to report to if you are injured or ill;
  - (e) Emergency signals: Fire/Man Overboard/Abandon Ship/Review of Drills;
  - (f) Helicopter use and safety;
  - (g) Rules for transit, boat-to-boat transfers, winching procedures.
