

PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT

Field personnel are issued individual personal safety and protective equipment. This equipment is to be carried at all times when proceeding on project, is to be kept in good condition, and worn or used in the manner for which it is intended. Any loss or damage is to be rectified by the employee at the earliest opportunity. The equipment is also to be used when onshore if the nature of the work makes this prudent.

The list of equipment currently provided is given below and will be revised as necessary to comply with particular project requirements or guidelines. Additional equipment is to be supplied for special purposes, to comply with particular contracts or at the discretion of the Company. Such additional equipment may be classified as "Personal" or "Company".

Safety Boots

Industrial boots with weather-resistant uppers, toe protection from weights and slip, chemical and heat-resistant soles.

Hard Hat

Standard approved. This must be worn during crane and other operations where overhead hazards are identified, as well as when an employee is working above another employee, and at all times when outside the accommodation areas on work vessels, camps and barges.

Safety Glasses

Standard approved for use with chemicals or hazardous substances, or during grinding, chipping or scraping. When working on decks of all work vessels.

Safety Gloves

Two types: rigger's gloves for handling ropes and general work gloves.

Safety Clothing

One pair of flotation coveralls, to be worn at all times when working on decks of all vessels.

A record of equipment issued to individuals is to be kept by the Operations Manager/Supervisor. Field Staff are to sign the record upon issue of equipment.

The Operations Manager/Supervisor and Party Chiefs are to carry out spot checks of personal safety equipment. Any defective, ineffective or missing equipment are to be investigated by the Operations Manager/Supervisor, and may result in disciplinary action being taken against the individual concerned.
