This letter constitutes the formal agreement ("Contract") between [Record Company] and yourself, whereby the Company agrees to retain you and you agree to provide your professional services as a musician for the purposes of making studio recordings ("Recordings"), all as hereinafter set forth.

Terms and Conditions:

1. You agree to provide your services to the Company on an exclusive basis during the term of this Contract and all extensions and/or renewals hereof, and that after the expiration of this Contract you will not record for anyone else any of the musical compositions recorded hereunder, and that in the event of a breach of this covenant, the Company shall be entitled to an injunction to enforce same, in addition to any other remedies available to it.
