

HAIR DRESSING SALON BOOTH / STATION LEASE AGREEMENT

For and in consideration of the mutual promises and stipulations contained in this Lease, Lessor does hereby lease to Lessee, and Lessee hereby leases from Lessor, the Leased Premises (as hereinafter described) upon the following terms and conditions.

1. Leased Premises

Lessor hereby leases to Lessee a space measuring approximately ____ feet by ____ feet, sufficient to operate a hair dressing station in Lessor's salon, _____ [insert name of salon], located at _____ [insert full address of salon].

2. Lessee's Right to Occupy

So long as Lessee is not in default hereunder, Lessee shall have the right to occupy the Leased Premises and to operate the hair dressing station as a business open to the public.

3. Term and Termination

- (a) This Lease shall commence on _____ [insert commencement date] and shall continue on a month to month basis until terminated by either party as provided herein.

4. Rent

5. Use of Leased Premises

- (a) Lessee shall use the Leased Premises solely for the operation of a hair dressing station. Lessee shall not use nor permit others to use the Leased Premises in any manner that violates any law, statute, ordinance or regulation now or hereafter in force and applicable to the Leased Premises. Lessee and Lessee's customers, guests, invitees and agents shall at all times comply with all of Lessor's rules and regulations in existence.
